This was in fact two separate projects that were constructed concurrently on the campus of the hospital.

The Ambulatory Surgery Center is a 2-story 35,000-square-foot outpatient surgery center building that includes four operating suites, a cystoscopy suite, eight outpatient nursing beds, eight recovery beds and 12 discharge rooms. Construction consists of a structural steel, CMU wall/brick veneer with cast stone accents and EFIS.

The 72,000 – square-foot, three-story, structural steel, Medical Office Building is adjacent to the Ambulatory Surgery Center and holds lease space for up to 20 office suites. The facility also houses a satellite laboratory facility, retail space and South Georgia Medical Center's Cardiac Rehab facility.
